



Create 100 Days of Color with Spring Blooming Bulbs!

Give yourself 100 days of spring beauty by planting bulbs that will bloom in early, mid, and late spring. The early season bulbs will often bloom before trees and shrubs start to leaf out in the spring, so they're a great solution to the winter blah's!

Combine a variety of bulbs, some of each category, into one bed (with proper spacing), and you will have constant blooms throughout the spring.

Bulb	Bulb Height
Early Season Blooms:	
Hyacinth	10" high
Crocus	4" high
Mid Season Blooms:	
Muscari	12" high
Tulip	24" high
Narcissus	16" high
Late Season Blooms:	
Allium	35" high
Bearded Iris	36" high
Dutch Iris	20" high
(some Dutch Iris will rebloom in summer & fall).
